The course is run in an entertaining interactive environment utilizing application workshops and real-live case studies.

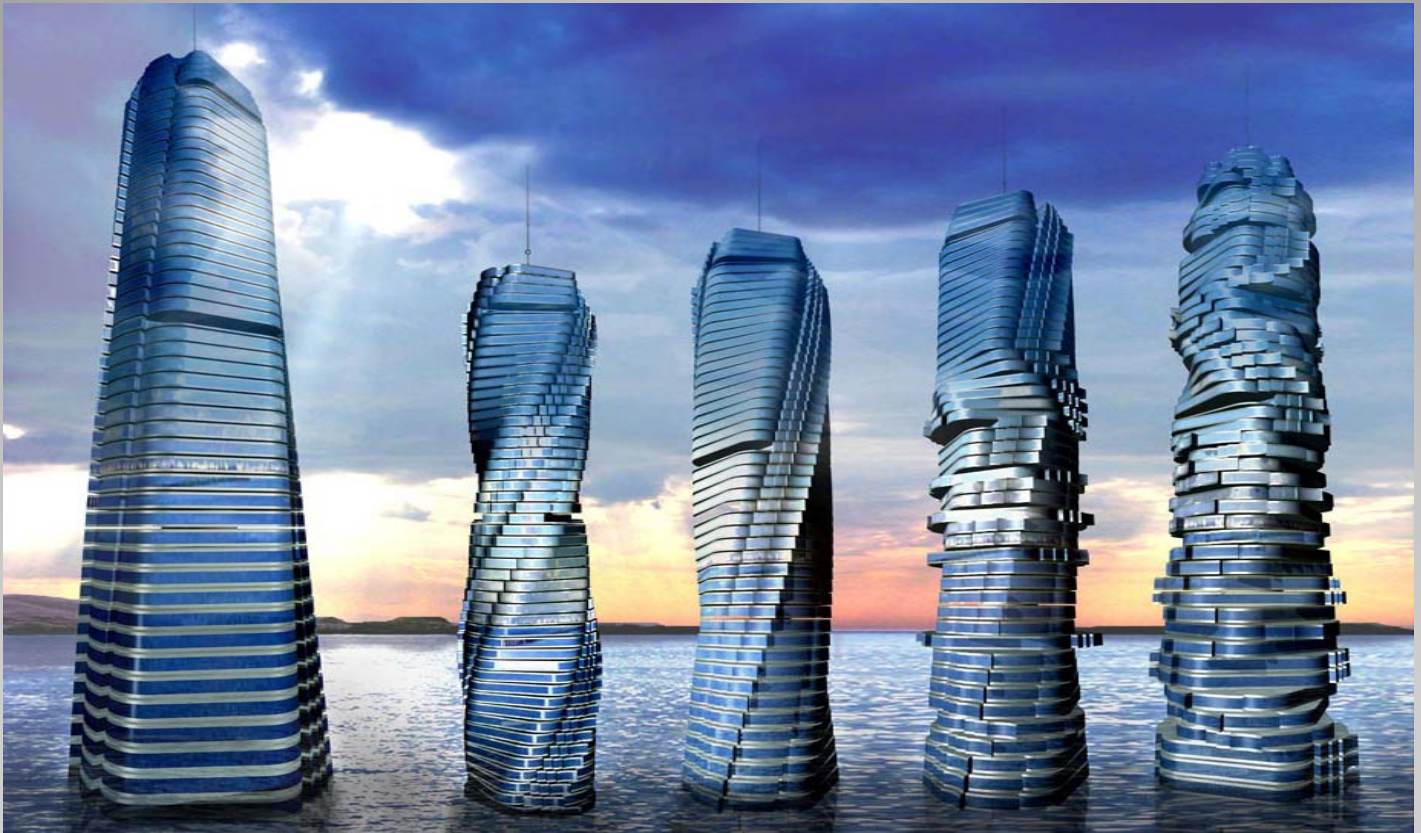
